## **Better and faster Internet access – an opportunity**

**We need your help to find out if there is sufficient interest from residents and local businesses in getting improved Internet access/ broad band speeds.**

The Parish Council is working with the County Council and BT Open reach to see if there is sufficient interest locally to apply for grant from the Government scheme to install fibre to premises broadband connections.

This would mean that connections would be faster, more reliable and could carry greater content as well as offering some future proofing for a world that sees more and more things done “on-line.” (Even if you are not a regular user or perhaps not even at all, getting a connection possibly at no cost, may be useful in the future)

If we can get enough expressions of interest from all premises and businesses in the parish this may mean that the grant would cover the cost of providing fibre to premises connections.

Other parishes in the county have or are in the process of taking advantage of this fund, and it appears that in most instances the costs can be covered.

We hope to complete the survey by the end of September.
